School Summary

West Dallas Community School provides a private, classical, Christian education (pre-K through eighth grade) to one of the most historically underserved communities in Dallas. The educational philosophy aims at the cultivation of wisdom and virtue, so while we are concerned with the development of skills, our primary focus is on nourishing the soul. Thus, WDCS's curriculum emphasizes nurturing our students' affections towards a love of the Good, the True, and the Beautiful. By God's grace, we are changing lives for generations to come for the good of the city & the glory of God.

Starting with 20 students in 1995, average enrollment has grown to 260 in the past few years. WDCS alumni are attending some of the best high schools in Dallas. Over our twenty-year history, 96% of graduates have gone on to complete high school and 73% have graduated from and or are currently enrolled in college. While each family is required to pay for a portion of tuition on a sliding scale, over 90% of the budget of the school is raised each year through donations and grants.
